**How much:** \$40 either in advance or at the door.

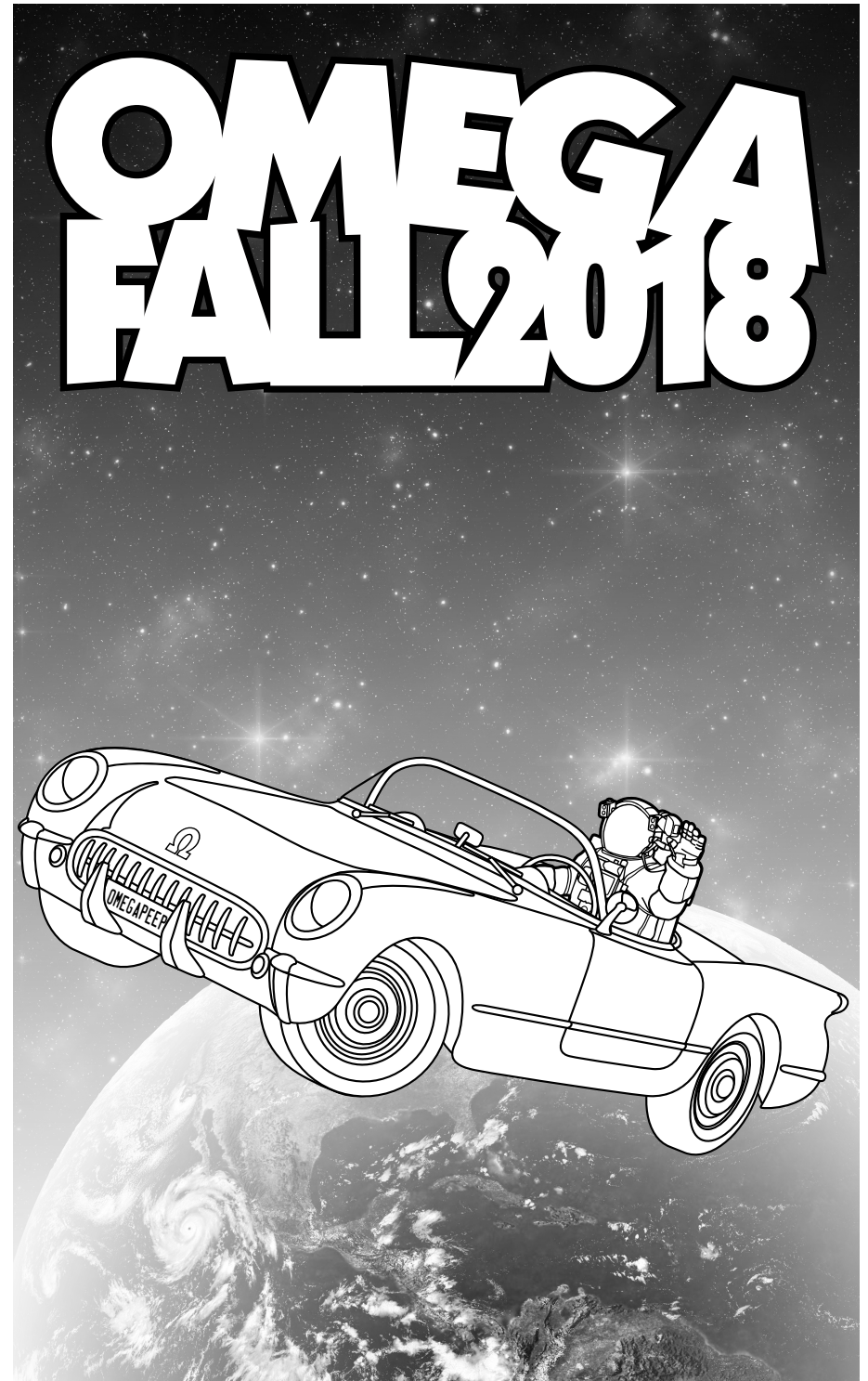
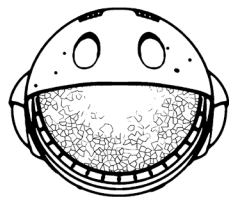
